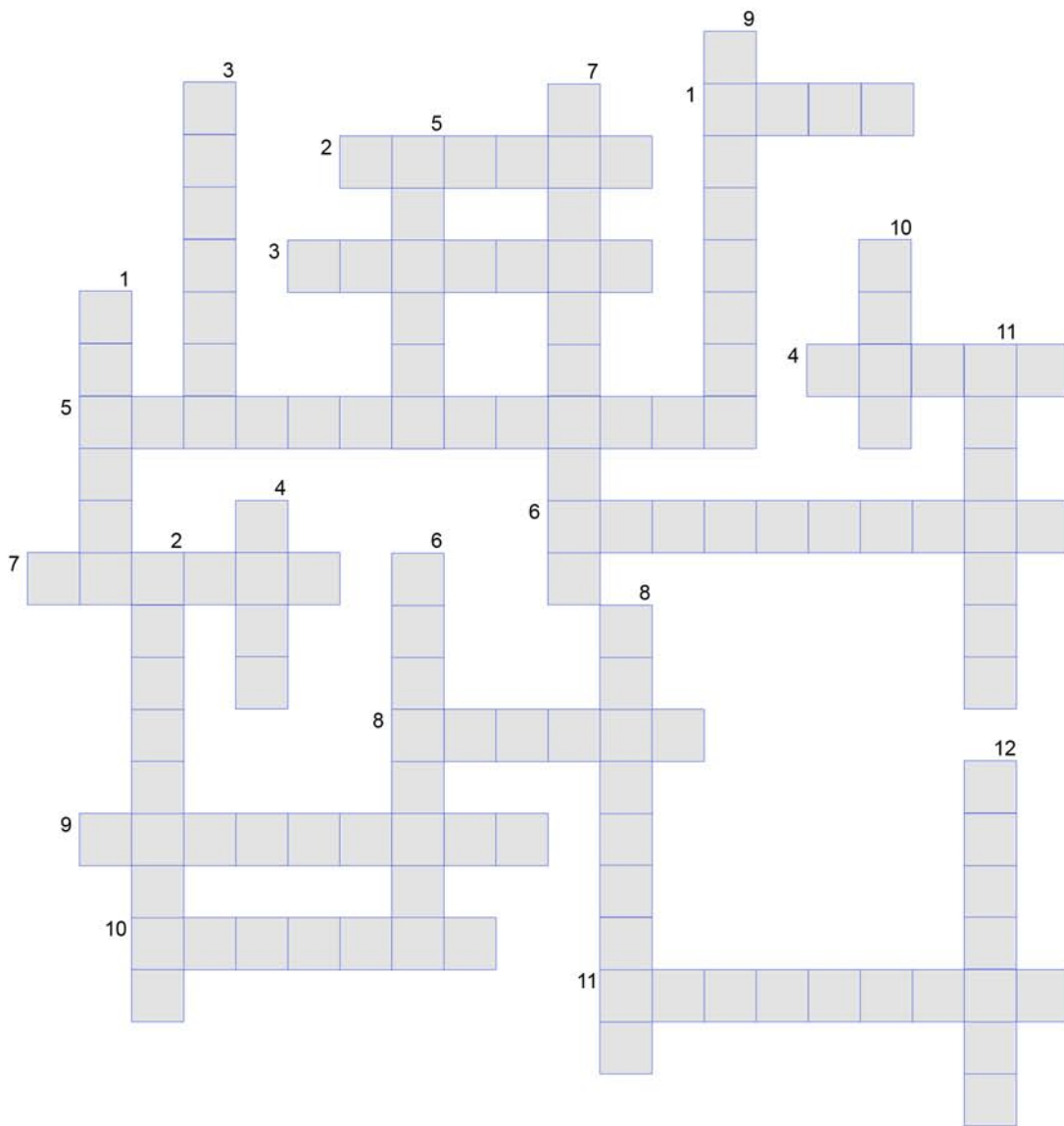




Coastal Dune Lakes Crossword Puzzle
